

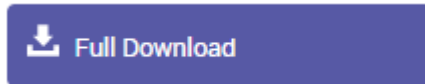
Using Adobe Digital Editions to download ebooks

When you want to download an ebook you will need either Adobe Digital Editions (for PC and Mac) or the Bluefire Reader app (iOS/Android).

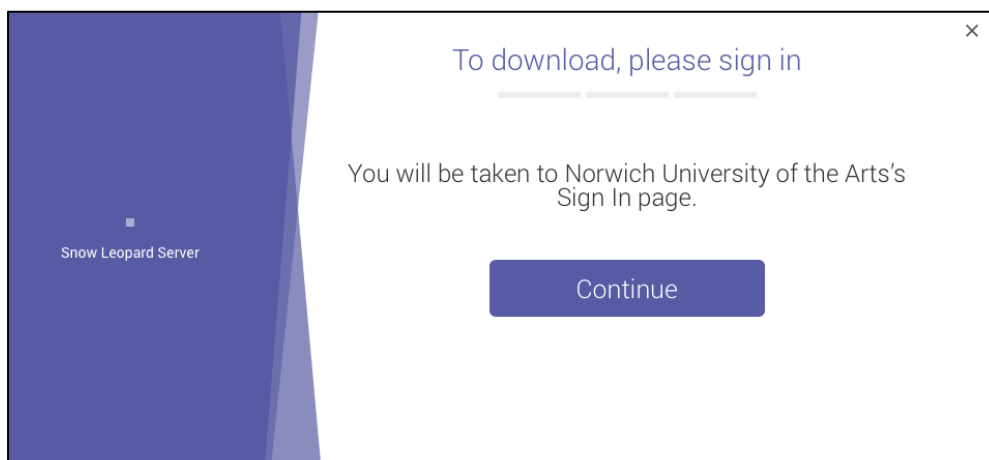
Adobe Digital Editions is installed on all student computers on campus. You can download it for free to use on your personal computer here: <http://www.adobe.com/uk/solutions/ebook/digital-editions/download.html>

How to download ebooks from Ebook Central

1. Click the download button in Ebook Central for the book you want:

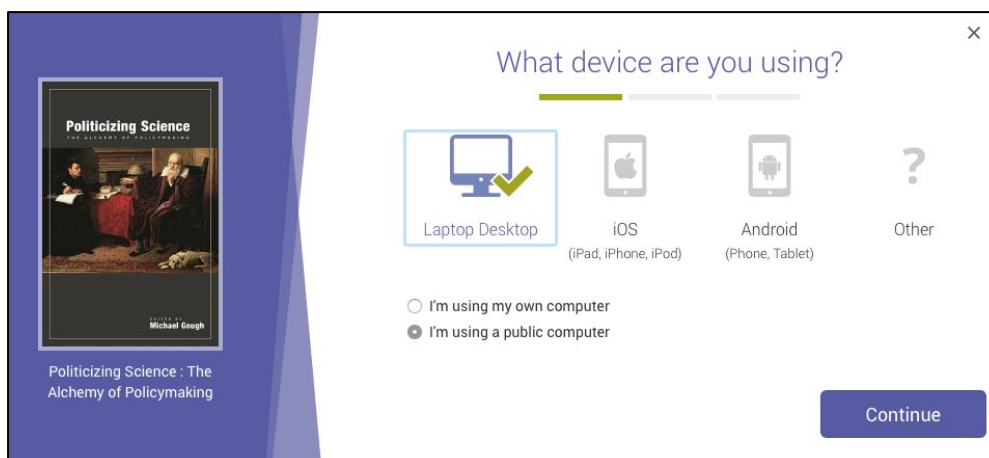


2. If you are not yet logged in, you will see this screen:

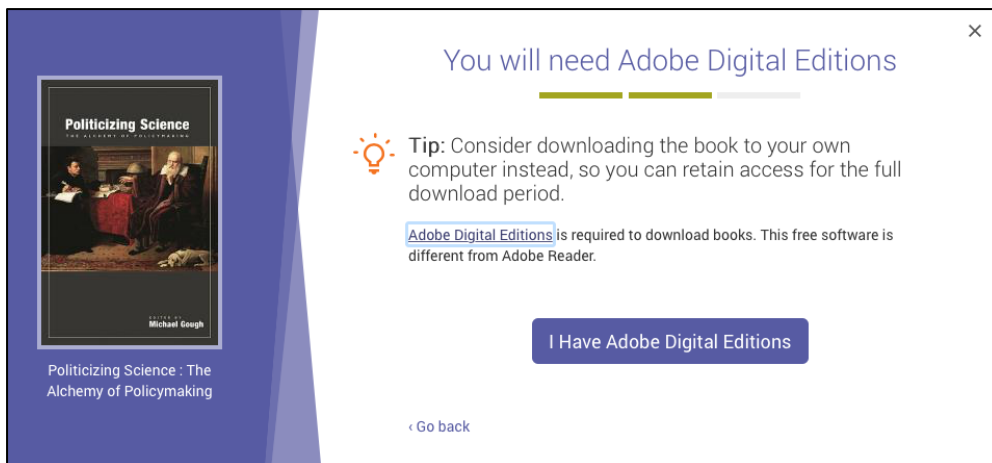


Click on 'continue' and follow the instructions to log in with your NUA username and password. You should then be directed back to the title you wish to download.

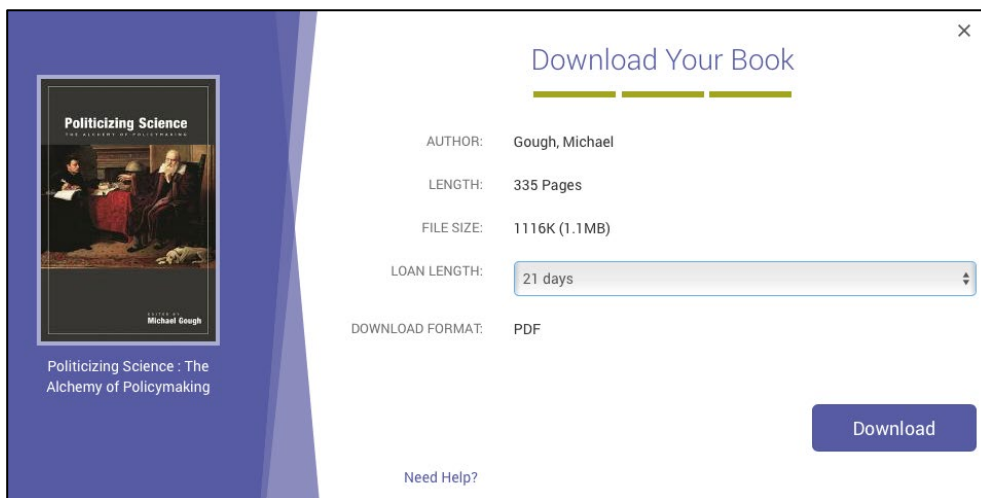
3. Select the device you are using, and whether you are using a public computer or your own computer. Ebook Central should be able to automatically detect which device you are using. Remember, if you are on campus you are using a public computer.



4. You will be prompted to install either Adobe Digital Editions or Bluefire Reader. If you haven't installed one of these you will need to in order to open the book. Remember, if you are on a campus computer Adobe Digital Editions is already downloaded, so you can click 'I have Adobe Digital Editions'

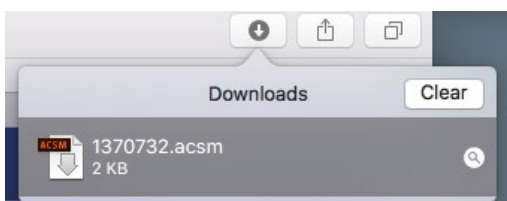


5. Choose the length of time you want to download the book for from the drop-down menu. When the loan expires the file will automatically remove itself from your computer/device, but you can always download it again if you wish.

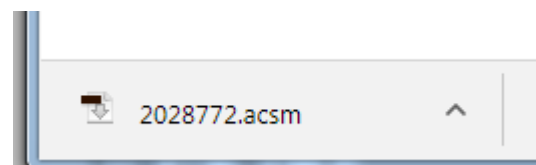


6. The download may automatically open Adobe Digital Editions, or may go to the 'downloads' bar on your browser.

e.g. Safari



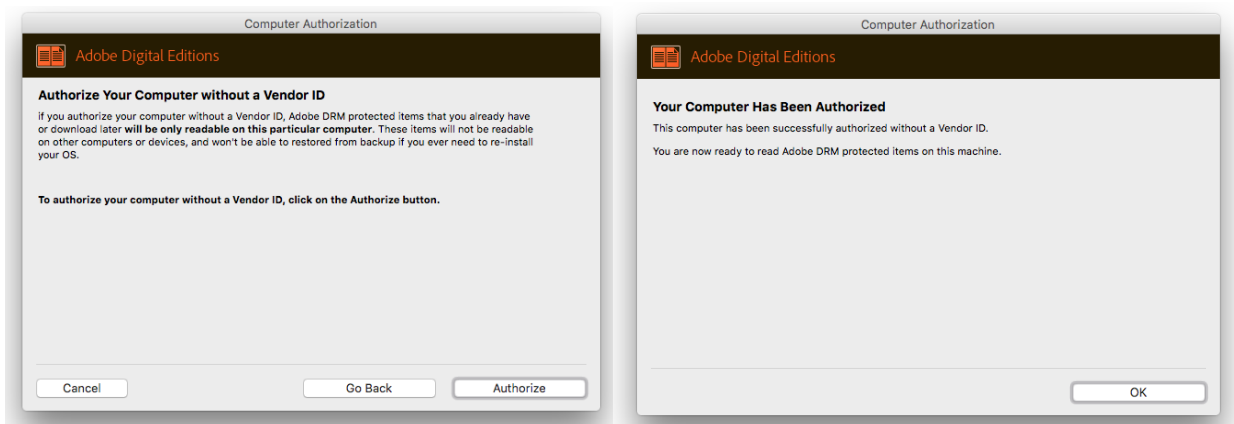
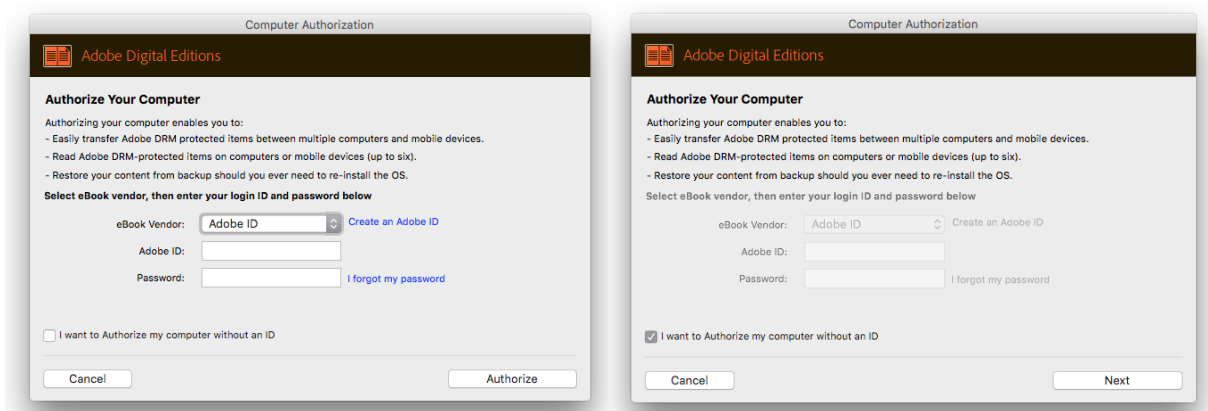
e.g. Chrome



Click on the download to open the book.

7. You will need to go through the Adobe authorisation process in order to read the book.

You need to select the tick box "I want to authorize my computer without an ID":
